

eCARE4KIDS Partners in Telepsychiatry

A Program of the Florida Medicaid Drug Therapy Management Program for Behavioral Health



The Florida Medicaid Drug Therapy Management Program at USF announces a new telepsychiatry program **eCARE4KIDS Partners in Telepsychiatry*** (a partnership with USF Health Department of Psychiatry in Tampa, All Children Hospital's Rothman Center in St. Petersburg) to improve access and reduce waiting time of behavioral health services to children and adolescents ages 0-21 regardless of insurance carrier.

The consultation with psychiatrist/therapist is free. Pediatricians/primary care physicians will bill for a telepsychiatry consult.

To schedule a telepsychiatry consult with eCARE4KIDS Partners in Telepsychiatry call 866-885-5437.

After completing the initial referral and informed consent forms available on the Program's website or by clicking the direct links below, the physician will securely fax the forms to **eCARE4KIDS Partners in Telepsychiatry** at 866-618-3533 to schedule a telepsychiatry/therapist consultation within one week or sooner.

- A desktop or laptop computer with a webcam, microphone and hard-wired internet connection.
- Installation of the free HIPAA compliant software (Skype for Business). The platform is easy to use and simple.
